NESTING BOXES



Combat habitat destruction by setting up nesting boxes in order to provide pollinators with sustainable places to live. For example, bee boxes.

Avoid chemical pesticides and allow natural debris (such as branches) to remain in garden spaces.

REUSE / UPCYCLE



Enhance and sustain gardens with reused and recycled materials. For example, use food scraps as natural fertilizers and use old jars and bottles to house and water plants.
